Wolff Praises NASDA On Salmonella

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — Agriculture Secretary Boyd E. Wolff today praised a Salmonella enteritidis control resolution passed by the National Association of State Departments of Agriculture (NASDA) at the organization's fall meeting.

Wolff helped spearhead passage of the NASDA resolution, which recommends that all states standardize their control measures for Salmonella enteritidis (SE).

"Public health matters and marketing of agricultural products should not be affected by state boundaries," Wolff said. "NASDA's resolution is important to

Pennsylvania's poultry industry because it tells all the states they should use the same set of control measures and laboratory procedures."

The NASDA resolution also urges USDA to amend federal rules so that restrictions be imposed only on infected flocks implicated in an SE outbreak, and that only an infected flock be restricted when SE is traced to a multiple flock production facility.

NASDA is a nonprofit, nonpartisan organization comprised of the 50 state departments of agri-

culture and those from the trust territories of Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa and the Virgin Islands. The members of the organization are commissioners, secretaries and directors of the departments of agriculture in the 50 states and four territories.

Wolff, who serves as chairman of NASDA's Dairy Food and Drug Committee, has also been elected chairman of the Northeastern Region (NEASDA) during the organization's fall meeting in Virginia this week.
