for uterus, and 75.1, 69.0, 68.4% for horn deposits, respectively.

Lastly, the Kansas and California study using repeat breeders indicated that around 20% of all dairy cows are in this category for various reasons, costing, an average, \$385 per lactation!

In five entire dairy herds in California and one in Kansas, the simultaneous treatment with gonadotropin-releasing hormone to A.I. resulted in significantly higher conception rates by an average 7 percentage points, while double A.I. (12 to 16 hours apart) did not have better conception rates.


However, timing of A.I. and type and time of hormone treatment relative to onset of estrus-whenever that is-- or ovulation remain factors in need of much more studies before we can truly claim to have solved the hardest job on the dairy farm, reproduction, and improve profitability in this critical area.
