WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW; OCT. 11-17, 1990. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO WEAK.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA HAD NO TREND DUE TO NO PRICES QUOTED LAST WEEK. MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO 50 CENT LOWER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY TO \$4.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE MOSTLY STEADY. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 2% BELOW A YEAR AGO AND 4% BELOW A YEAR AGO AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE 25 CENTS HIGHER TO 50 CENT LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE MOSTLY STEADY. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 4% BELOW A YEAR AGO AND 6% BELOW A YEAR AGO

AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHT WERE 1 POUND LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$1.50 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE 50 CENT TO \$2.50 LOWER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE MOSTLY STEADY TO \$10.00 LOWER WITH BELLIES \$20.00-23.00 LOWER. HOG PRODUCTION WAS 3% BELOW A YEAR AGO AND 9% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

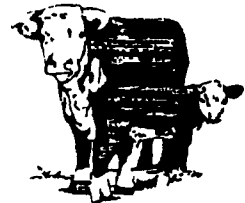

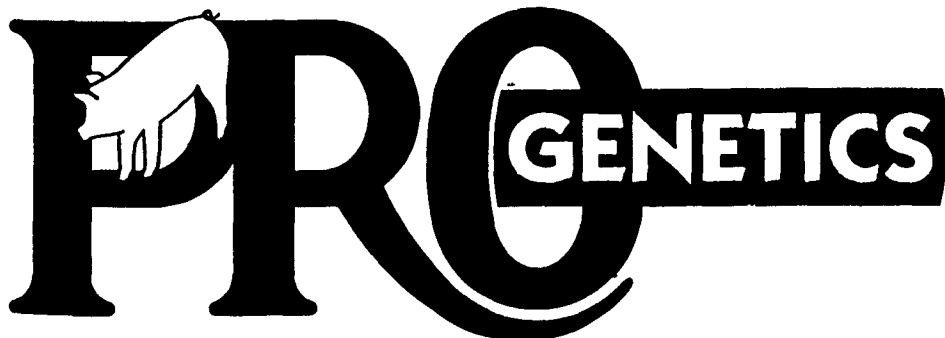
