MARKETS IN REVIEW: OCT. 18-24, 1990. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$2.25-3.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 LOWER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00-2.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO 75 CENT HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY TO \$3.25 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 LOWER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 3% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 4% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 8 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE

MIXED 75 CENT HIGHER TO \$2.00 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 5% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 2% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE THE SAME AS LAST YEAR.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE 50 CENT LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.50 LOWER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE MOSTLY \$2.00- 7.00 LOWER. HOG PRODUCTION WAS LESS THAN 1% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 9% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE THE SAME AS LAST YEAR.

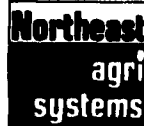

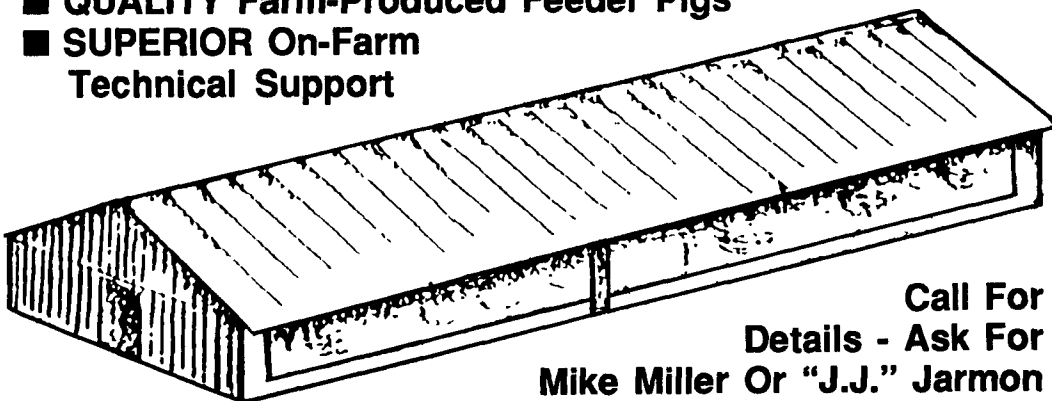
