

Congressman Traficant To Address PFU

BROOKSVILLE (Jefferson Co.) — Congressman James Traficant from Youngstown, Ohio will be the Keynote Speaker at the Pennsylvania Farmers Union (PFU) annual banquet on Thursday, November 8, 1990. The banquet at 7:00 p.m. will be preceded by a reception from 6:30 to 7:00 p.m. and is being held in conjunction with PFU's 19th Annual State Convention. This year's convention will be held at the Days' Inn, Brookville (Jefferson County).

Congressman Traficant, a former Sheriff from Mahoning County, represents the 17th Congressional District. He was first elected as a Congressman in 1984 without the support of his party and managed to win with an 18,000 vote margin over the three term incumbent opponent. He

conducted a low-budget grassroots campaign and was outspent nearly seven to one. He was re-elected by receiving more than 72% of the vote in 1986 and in 1988 Traficant again maintained an overwhelming majority.

Allen Deiter, President of Pennsylvania Farmers Union, will call the convention to order at 12:00 Noon on November 8. President Deiter said, "We are privileged to once again have Congressman Traficant address our convention". According to the PFU leader, Traficant is completing his third term as a member of the United States House of Representatives, and has compiled an outstanding record in support of our family farmers. President Deiter further stated that during the second session of the 101st Congress,

Traficant scored better than a 90% voting record in support of the National Farmers Union position on key legislative issues.

Leland Swenson, President of National Farmers Union, from Denver Colorado, will be the guest speaker during Friday night's dinner. This event also begins at 7:00 p.m. Mr. Swenson is serving in his second term as NFU President. Because of his strong stand in support of family farmers, Mr. Swenson has become well known in the International agricultural communities as well as in the United States. Mr. Swen-

son also has taken a strong stand concerning fair trade agreements and the need to revitalize rural communities around the world.
