COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER FOLLOWING MIDWEST PRICES WERE ALSO STEADY TO \$1 00 HIGH-ER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS LESS THAN 1 % ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 5% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 6 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00-6.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1 00 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 2% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 4% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 3 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.


