DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 6 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO. LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00-6.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 2% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 4% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 3 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.
