STATE COLLEGE (Centre Co.) — Attention, Pennsylvania Junior Holstein members! The 1991 Jr. Holstein Convention is rapidly approaching.

This year's convention will be Feb. 1-3, at the Sheraton Berkshire in Reading. The convention theme is "Come out and Join the Fun in 91!"

Committees have been formed to plan for this event. The 1991 Pa. Jr. Holstein Convention will be the third Jr. Convention held separately from the adult convention. The first two conventions have been very successful. Plan on joining the fun, as this year will prove to be even more thrilling!

As always, the Junior Convention will feature many activities including: tours, the dairy bowl contest, the lip sync contest, and numerous other events. There will also be, as always, a dairy bar.

Plan on arriving at the Sheraton on Friday night, Feb. 1. The dairy bowl teams will have their seeding quiz at 7-8 p.m., registration will begin at 5 p.m.

The pool will be open for swimming until the Ag Olympics begin at 8:15 p.m. This new twist will feature "contests" farmers do on a daily basis. So get your county teams and individuals in shape for the Pennsylvania Junior Holsteins version of the Olympics. Following the Olympic games there will

be a pizza and swimming party. On Saturday, the dairy bar will be open from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., offering many dairy snacks. The dairy bowl contest will begin at 8:30 a.m., and last most of the day; the final will be at 3:15 p.m.

For the Juniors not participating in the dairy bowl contest there will be tours, from 8 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. of Plushanski Farms, Rothrock Golden Holsteins, and Junge Farms.

This year there will be two workshops on fitting cattle and embryo transfer.

The annual meeting will be held at 4 p.m., followed by a buffet dinner at 5:30 p.m.

As entertainment for the buffet there will be a hypnotist. At 8 p.m. a movie will be shown, then DJ Tim Schafer will help rock the night away! Don't forget the lip sync contest, get your group ready to perform.

After a few hours of sleep, Sunday morning will bring the awards banquet, with guest speaker Mike King. The dairy bar will also be open Sunday morning.

This year, there will be an art contest. The contest will be split into two divisions, ages 9-14 and ages 15-21. Each division will have two separate categories, photos and sketches of paintings. Prizes will be awarded to winners of each division. Winners will be determined by peoples' choice

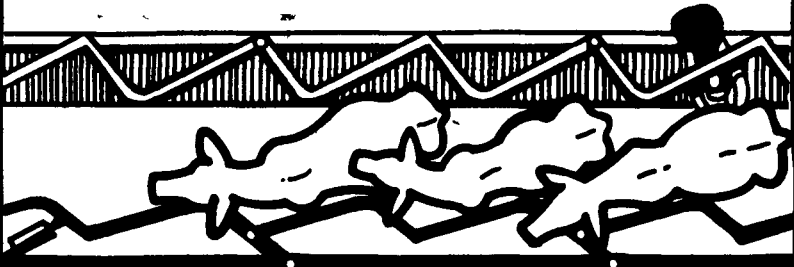
and a critics' impression.

There is a one entry per Junior limit for this contest.

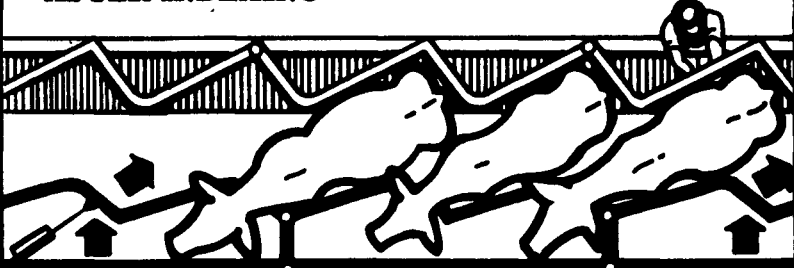
Last year's convention drew a larger attendance than the '89 convention, and this year, Holstein Juniors will be bigger and better than ever.

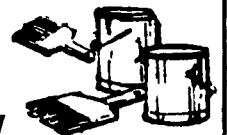
