SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINA WERE \$2.50-4.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE MOSTLY \$1.00 HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.50-2.25 HIGHER AS MID-WEST PRICES WERE MIXED, \$1.00 LOWER TO \$1.00 HIGHER, BEEF PRO-DUCTION WAS '9% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 2% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.


