

## Maryland Team Competes

### In National Dairy Bowl

COLLEGE PARK, Md. — Carroll County's state champion senior 4-H dairy bowl team and a Montgomery County 4-H member represented Maryland in the National 4-H Dairy Quiz Bowl, held Nov. 3 during the North American International Livestock Exposition which ended Nov. 16 at Louisville, Ky.

Maryland's delegation finished sixth among 21 state teams—being defeated in consecutive rounds by the teams which fin-

ished first and third. The first-place team hailed from Somerset County, Pa.

J. W. Wothlie, 16, of Mount Airy captioned the Maryland team. Other Carroll County members were Bryan Harris, 15, of Westminster and Denny Widner, 17, of Warfieldsburg.

Jenny S. Savage, 14, of Ladiesburg (Frederick County) was the fourth Maryland 4-H dairy bowl team member. She is a Montgomery County 4-H member.
