College of Agriculture, American Sheep Industry Association and Allied Industry. Numerous sewing companies donate items such as wool fabric and sewing accessories as prizes for the contestants.

Judges for the event were Marilyn Engle, home economist from Pennsylvania Furnace; Paula Ewalt, president of the Keystone

Polypay Association; and Mary Alice Fyock, home economist from Lititz.

State directors for the annual contest are Janet Mawhinney of Waynesburg and Shirely Dunn of Chicora. Mawhinney said that the purpose of the contest is to promote wool. The outfits show the

wide variety of textures and patterns available in wool fabrics.

Wool gives better performance for less money over a longer period of time than any other fabric. Nature has endowed wool with natural characteristics that can't be worn away: wrinkle resistance, soil resistance, ready shape recovery and easy care. Many woolens are now machine washable and dryable.

Wool is cool in the summer and warm in winter since it has its own built-in thermostat; it breathes; it can absorb 30% of its own weight without losing heat, and is color-fast and flame-resistant.

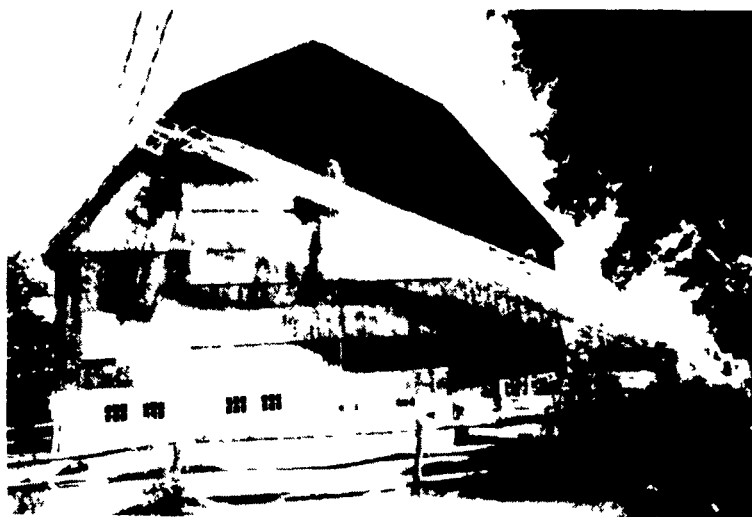

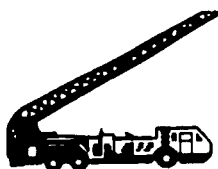
