Remember these are averages so you will need to adjust your figures up or down according to your location and the quality of your crop.

- Corn, No. 2y - 2.42 BU. 4.33 CWT.
- Wheat, No. 2 - 2.67 BU. 4.46 CWT.
- Barley, No. 3 - 1.98 BU. 4.24 CWT.
- Oats, No. 2 - 1.40 BU. 4.37 CWT.
- Soybeans, No. 1 - 5.58 BU. 9.32 CWT.
- New Ear Corn - 56.72 BU. 2.84 CWT.
- Alfalfa Hay - 100.00 BU. 5.00 CWT.
- Mixed Hay - 87.50 BU. 4.38 CWT.
- Timothy Hay - 87.00 BU. 4.35 CWT.
