## Research Targets **Producer Priorities**

DES MOINES, IA—Researchers throughout the U.S. have sent in 172 production research proposals to the National Pork Board for funding in 1991. In the past, the Pork Board has funded about \$400,000 in competitive research grants.

"The overall research funding philosophy is to find ways to produce pork more efficiently by lowering input costs and improving product quality," said National Pork Board President Hilman Schroeder. "All research funding decisions are made in accordance with producer directives drawn from a series of priority planning meetings and producer surveys.'

Using the priorities established by producers, a diverse committee of producers and scientists will meet next month to review and select the projects that will receive

1991 funding.

The Pork Board funds about 30-40 research grants each year. In addition, funds from universities and other agencies are utilized so that the Pork Board can leverage its checkoff dollars to direct approximately \$1 million worth of pork industry research.


The Pork Board funds production research in areas such as swine nutrition, swine health, genetics, health, environment, management, marketing and facilities. Some of the past checkofffunded research successes have led to the development of new swine vaccines, better nutritional recommendations, genetic improvement and pseudorabies (PRV) eradication tools.

Production research is one of the many research categories funded by the Pork Board.




