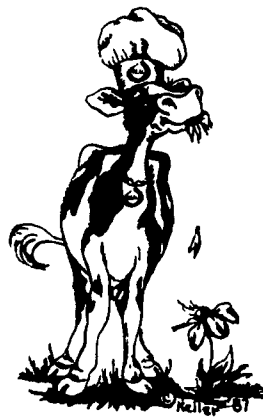

The most recent report from the Pa. Ag Statistics Service (PASS) indicates that there were 682,000 milk cows as of September 1990.

We have averaged about 17,000 fewer cows for the first nine months of 1990 versus 1989.

Although the last 4 months have been on the plus side, milk production for the first nine months was 173 million pounds below the 1989 figure.
