IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00-8.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE

MOSTLY \$8.00 LOWER.

SLAUGHTER CATTLE PRICES IN VIRGINIA HAD NO COMPARISON FOR LAST WEEK BUT WERE SLIGHTLY WEAKER. MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.50 LOWER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$3.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE 50 CENT TO \$1.00 LOWER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 30% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 8% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 12 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED, \$7.50 LOWER TO \$1.50 HIGHER, MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 34% ABOVE A

WEEK AGO AND 4% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 3 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE 50 CENT HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE MIXED 25 CENT LOWER TO 50 CENT HIGHER. HOG PRODUCTION WAS 34% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 12% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. A VERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 4 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

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
