MARKETS IN REVIEW; JAN. 17-23, 1991. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY TO \$2.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.75-3 50 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER CATTLE PRICES IN VIRGINIA FOLLOWED MIDWEST PRICES AND REMAINED MOSTLY STEADY.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$6.25 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO 50 CENT HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS LESS THAN 1% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 10% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 9 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO
