DAILY NATIONAL GRAIN MARK-ET SUMMARY CASH GRAIN AND SOYBEAN PRICES LOWER WEDNES-DAY WHEAT 1-3 CENTS LOWER EXCEPT MINNEAPOLIS 1-2 CENTS HIGHER; CORN STEADY 10 1 CENT LOWER; SORGHUM 1 CENT LOWER; SOYBEANS MOSTLY I CENT LOWER ALTHOUGH WAR IN THE PERSIAN GULF RAGES ON, GRAIN AND SOY-BEAN PRICES INFLUENCED MAINLY BY USS.R/BALTIC CONFLICT. WHEAT PRICES FELL ON REJECTION OF US S.R.'S EXPORT BONUS FEED QUALITY WHEAT BID.
