DAILY NATIONAL GRAIN MARKET SUMMARY CASH GRAIN AND SOYBEAN PRICES LOWER WEDNESDAY WHEAT 1-3 CENTS LOWER EXCEPT MINNEAPOLIS 1-2 CENTS HIGHER; CORN STEADY TO 1 CENT LOWER; SORGHUM 1 CENT LOWER; SOYBEANS MOSTLY 1 CENT LOWER. ALTHOUGH WAR IN THE PERSIAN GULF RAGES ON, GRAIN AND SOYBEAN PRICES INFLUENCED MAINLY BY U.S.S.R./BALTIMORE CONFLICT. WHEAT PRICES TELL ON REJECTION OF U.S.S.R.'S EXPORT BONUS FEED QUALITY WHEAT BID. HOWEVER, EGYPT'S PURCHASE FOR SOFT WHITE WHEAT LIMITED LOSSES CORN PRICES SLIGHTLY LOWER, PRESSURED BY FEAR OF NO FUTURE EXPORT CORN DEMAND FROM U.S.S.R. SOYBEAN PRICES DECLINED AFTER YESTERDAY'S SHARP RALLY AS TRADERS MADE ADJUSTMENTS. LITTLE EXPORT BUSINESS AND DRY WEATHER IN SOUTHERN BRAZIL ALSO WEAKENED BEAN PRICES
