Pearl Hoffman and Janet Schlegel reported on events at the State Convention. They served as delegates from Group #6.

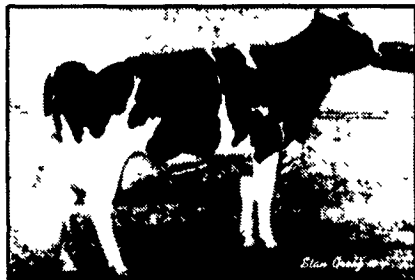
The next meeting will be at the Pleasantville Diner on February 19, with lunch at 11:30 a.m. Valentines will be exchanged and each member should wear something red.

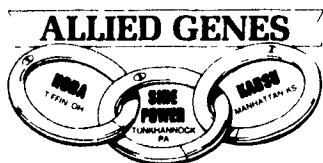

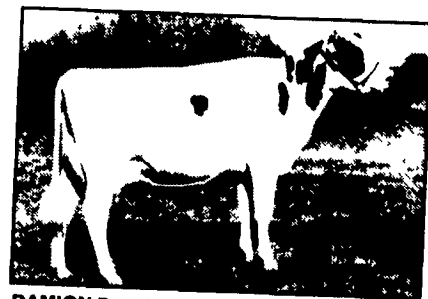
