

Potato Growers Will Meet

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.)— This year's Potato Growers Institute promises to be an information-packed seminar on the most important problems and issues facing potato growers in the coming decade.

The seminar will be held at Willow Valley Family Resort at Willow Street, located three miles south of Lancaster on Routes 222 and 272.

Tuesday's session will deal with table and process market panel discussions with an opportunity for audience interaction, breeding programs discussions, variety and seed presentations, etc. Presenters will be Dr. Robert Plaisted, plant breeder/Cornell; Dr. Steve Slack, New York State Seed Program/Cornell; and various buyers tables and process industries.
