

Vegetable Day Looks At Grower Concerns

NEW HOLLAND (Lancaster Co.) — The Adult Farmer Program of the Eastern Lancaster County School District will conduct an all-day program for vegetable growers at the Summit Valley Elementary School on Monday, February 18, 1991.

The program will begin at 9 a.m. with coffee, donuts, and visiting exhibits. General sessions will cover topics such as vegetable diseases, growing cool season crops, and management practices to optimize vegetable production.

There will be a series of concurrent meetings going on during the day including topics on vegetable fertilization, strawberries, greenhouse tomato production, greenhouse biosecurity, starting and expanding greenhouses, and tree fruit management.

In addition, several video tapes will be shown during the day on integrated pest management, food watch, and stress on the family farm. Also a special demonstration on stir frying will be of inter-

est to the ladies attending. An explanation of the vegetable referendum money collected from vegetable growers will also be presented.

Producers may want to bring more than one member of the family in order to attend sessions going on at the same time.

Credits toward pesticide recertification will be awarded to those with private applicator licenses. Be sure to bring your current private applicator license with you. Some special sessions for those needing category credits for soil fumigation will be held in the afternoon.

Presenters on the program will include Agway vegetable specialists Frank Donohue and Phil Dimick; Steve Reiners, Rutgers University horticulture specialist; Ted Shenk, local producer; Bruce Hellerick, Lancaster County horticulture agent; Floyd Rank, Erth-Rite; Larry Yager, extension marketing specialist; and reps from several ag supply and chemical companies.

The Summit Valley Elementary

School is located on Eastern School Rd., 1½ miles south of New Holland between Brimmer and Kinzer Avenues. The meeting will be in the all-purpose room on the east side of the building.
