MARKETS IN REVIEW; JAN. 31-FEB.6, 1991. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.50 LOWER TO \$4.00 HIGHER FOLLOW-ING MIDWEST PRICES WHICH WERE \$1.50 HIGHER TO \$5.25 LOWER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$3.50 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES

WERE STEADY TO 50 CENT HIGHER. COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY TO \$3.75 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-2.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUC-TION WAS 5% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 4% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE UNEVEN, 50 CENT HIGHER TO \$1.75 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE ALSO UNEVEN, \$1.00 HIGHER TO \$2.00 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 1% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 5% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.


