My house has 70 house plants on the first floor windowsills and some 50 on bedroom windowsills. They get watered every week or oftener as I enjoy seeing them grow. This year I planted a small cherry tomato plant in a plastic pot and put it on a sill in our bedroom. At this writing it is three feet tall and still climbing. It has bloomed several times but I'm not sure if it will have any tomatoes. A few years ago a reader wrote to me and said that I should brush the flowers with a bunny tail to pollinate them. Maybe I'll try that.

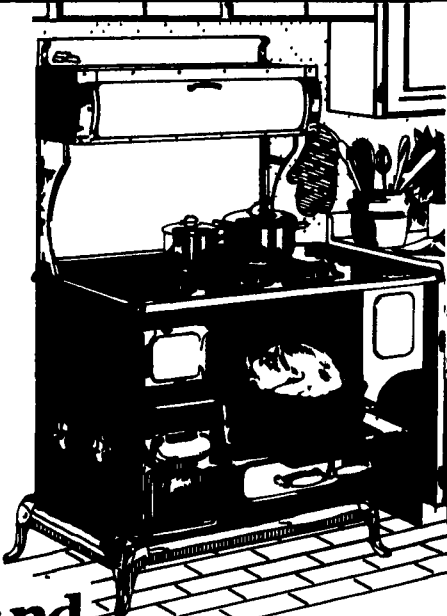

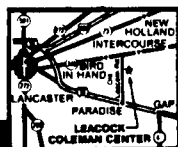
