MARKETS IN REVIEW; FEB. 14-20, 1991. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY \$2.00-8.00 LOWER WHILE MIDWEST PRICES WERE MIXED, 50 CENT HIGHER TO \$9.00 LOWER.
SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE 25-75 CENT HIGHER.
COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA FOUND COWS \$2.00-3.00 HIGHER AND BULLS \$2.50-7.00 LOWER, MIDWEST COWS AND BULLS WERE \$1.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 3% HIGHER THAN A WEEK AGO AND 4% HIGHER THAN A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

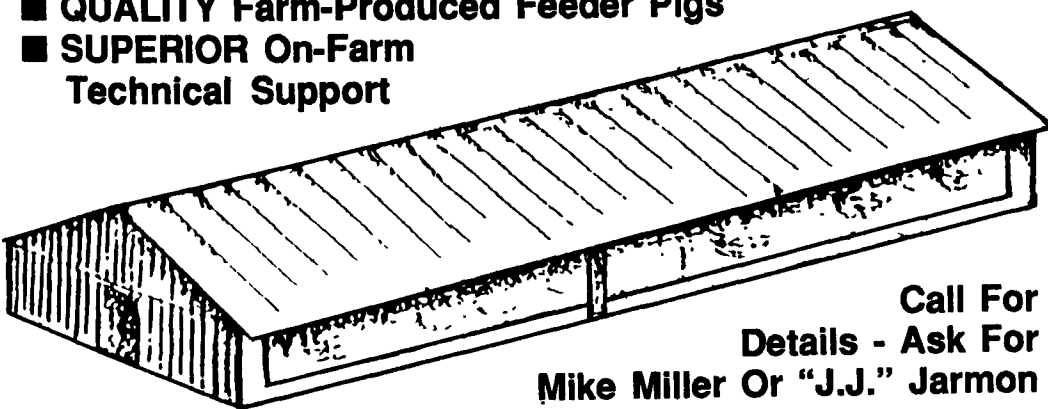
