WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA: MARKETS IN REVIEW; FEB 21-27, 1991. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA UNEVEN, \$9.00-10.50 HIGHER ON LIGHT WEIGHT CATTLE AND \$6.00-7.00 LOWER ON HEAVIER CATTLE. MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$3.00-14.00 HIGHER. SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-

ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$3.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE MOSTLY STEADY. COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA MIXED, \$1.00-6.00 LOWER TO \$9.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00 LOWER TO \$2.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 4% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND STEADY WITH A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED

WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO. LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.75-2.00 HIGHER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 4% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 5% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO. SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.50 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE 75 CENT TO \$1.00 LOWER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$10.00 LOWER. HOG PRODUCTION WAS LESS THAN 1% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 3% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 5 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.
