Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged at 47-60 cents. Live supplies were adequate. Average live weights were in a desirable range. Processing schedules were heavy. Trade sentiment was steady. In the parts complex, supplies of boneless skinless breast were in good balance for immediate needs, dark meat was adequate to fully adequate, whole breast were adequate.
