MARKETS IN REVIEW; MARCH 21-27, 1991.

FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$3.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE 25 CENT TO \$1.25 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$2.50-3.75 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.50-2.00 LOWER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED, \$1.00 HIGHER TO \$1.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-4.00 LOWER. BEEF PRODUC-TION WAS 7% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 5% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 13 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A

STEADY TO \$3.50 LOWER AS MID-WEST PRICES WERE \$3.00 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 6% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 35% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE THE SAME AS LAST YEAR.
