

Forest Landowner's Workshop Set

CREAMERY (Montgomery Co.) — Pennsylvania is known as the source of some of the finest hardwood timber in the world. The value of the timber in your woodlot is probably more than you realize, so it pays to learn all you can about managing this valuable resource.

To help you do just that, a "Forest Landowners' Workshop" will be held on Saturday, April 13, at Pennypack Forest, 2955 Edge Hill Road, Huntingdon Valley, Pa.

This workshop is designed to help private forest landowners who want to do a better job of managing their woodlands — whether they want to sell the timber, improve wildlife habitat, or

simply have a nice view.

Foresters from Penn State and private industry will explain a wide range of topics, including "Pennsylvania's Forest Resources," "Basics of Forestry," "Developing a Management Plan," "The Role of Harvesting in Meeting Your Objectives," "Special Topics in Woodlot Management," "Managing Woodlots for Wildlife," "Forest Taxation," and "Woodlot Services."

The workshop will start at 8:30 a.m. and the program will run until 3 p.m. Registration fee will be \$15 per person and this includes lunch and an indexed reference notebook containing a wealth of information and references for the pri-

vate forest landowner.

The notebook alone is worth the registration fee. This workshop is being co-sponsored by the Pennsylvania's Forest Stewardship Program, The Pennsylvania Forestry Association, Penn State College of Agriculture School of Forest Resources, Pennypack Watershed Association, Bucks and Montgomery Counties Cooperative Extension, and Hardwoods Development Council.

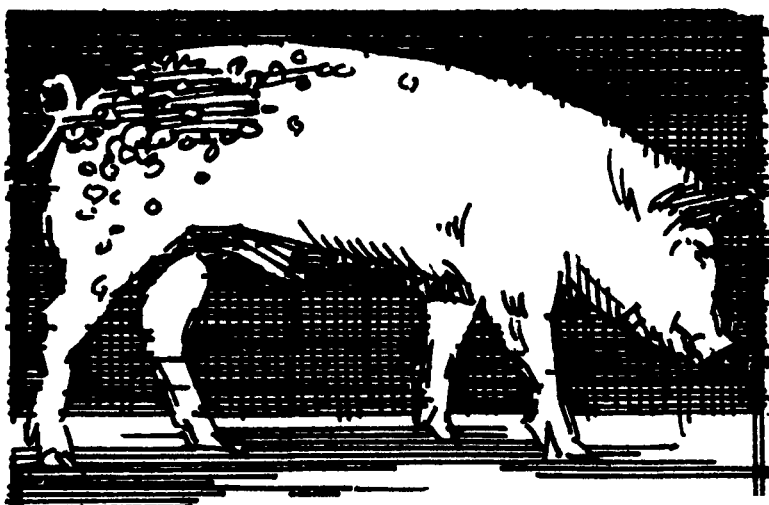

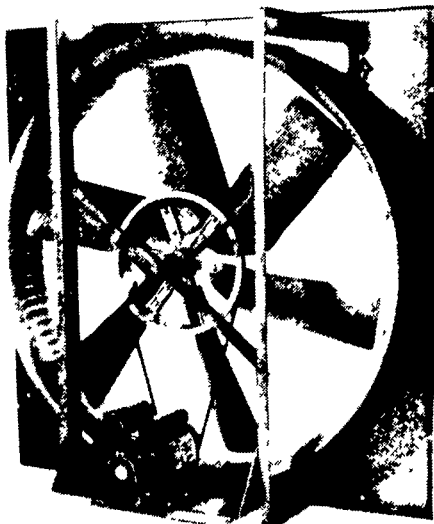

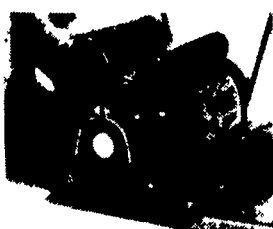
