WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW; MARCH 28-APRIL 3, 1991. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA HAD STEERS \$2.00-3.00 LOWER AND HEIFERS STEADY TO \$3.00 HIGHER. MIDWEST PRICES WERE MIXED \$9.00 HIGHER TO \$2.00 LOWER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE 50 CENT TO \$2.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-2.00 HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE 50 CENT TO \$3.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-3.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 8% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 12% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 17 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE UNEVEN, \$5.00 HIGHER TO \$5.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 HIGHER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 26% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 9% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE THE SAME AS A YEAR AGO.
