WHEAT 1 TO 5 CENTS HIGHER; CORN 1 TO 2 CENTS HIGHER; SORGHUM 3 CENTS HIGHER; SOYBEANS 3 TO 7 CENTS HIGHER. LITTLE RAIN IN FORECAST FOR CENTRAL PLAINS AND DRY SOIL CONDITIONS AFTER UNSEASONABLY DRY WINTER, SUPPORTED WHEAT PRICES. CORN PRICES STRONGER ON FUND BUYING AND SHORT COVERINGS ON THE BOARD. TRADERS EVENING POSITIONS BEFORE TODAY'S SUPPLY AND DEMAND REPORT ALSO BOOSTED CORN PRICES. HIGHER SOYBEAN PRICES DUE TO CONSOLIDATION MOVES TO YESTERDAY'S LOSSES. 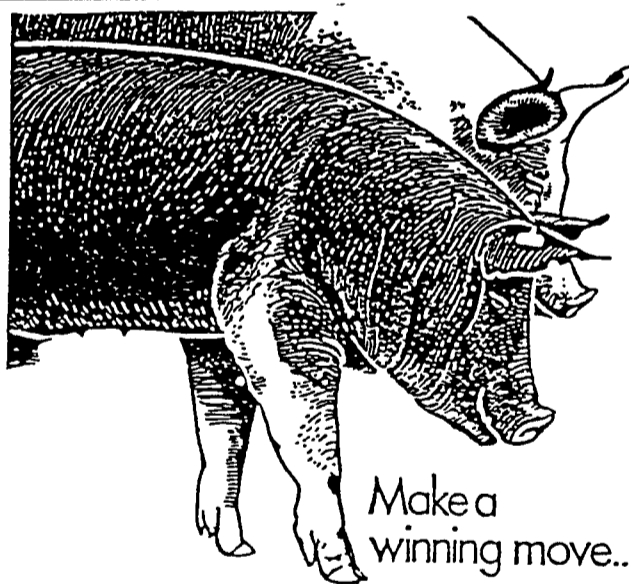
