MARKETS IN REVIEW; APRIL 4-10, 1991. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE 50 CENT TO \$3.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$11.00 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$1.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00 LOWER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 8% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 1% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 23 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE UNEVEN, \$3.00 LOWER TO \$4.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.50 HIGHER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 4% BELOW A

WEEK AGO AND 22% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 4 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE MIXED, 25 CENT LOWER TO 25 CENT HIGHER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$4.00 HIGHER EXCEPT BELLIES WHICH WERE \$2.50 LOWER. 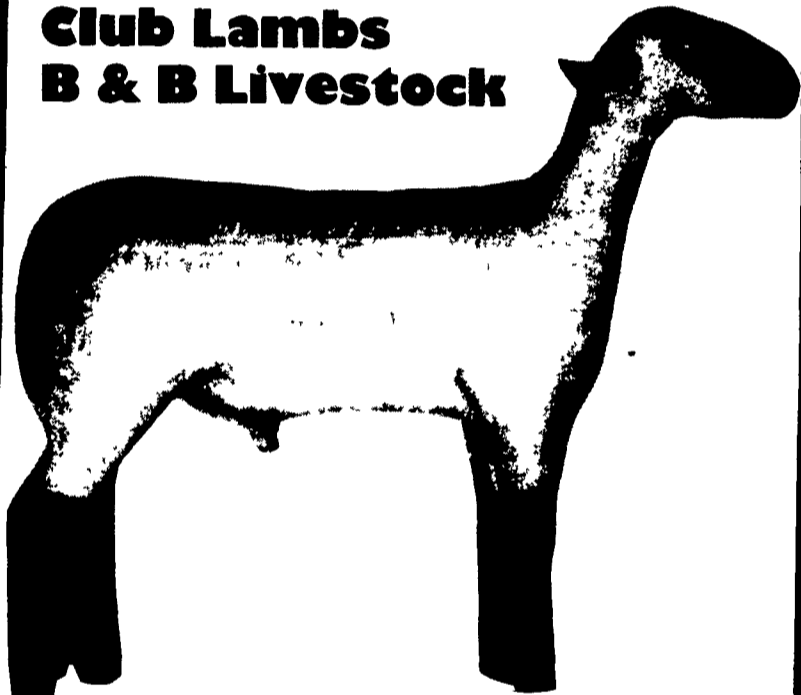

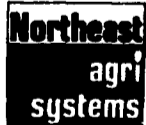
