USDA DAILY NATIONAL GRAIN MARKET SUMMARY GRAIN AND SOYBEAN PRICES CLOSED MOSTLY LOWER WEDNESDAY INFLUENCED BY VERY LIGHT EXPORT ACTIVITY, GOOD WEATHER CONDITIONS IN PRODUCING AREAS. THE NATIONAL RAIL STRIKE ALSO A PROBLEM. WHEAT 1 TO 2 CENTS LOWER EXCEPT PORTLAND 1 TO 2 CENTS HIGHER; CORN 2 TO 3 CENTS LOWER; SORGHUM 5 TO 7 CENTS LOWER; SOYBEANS 5 TO 8 CENTS LOWER CONTRACT TALKS BETWEEN FREIGHT RAILROADS AND THEIR UNIONS FAILED TO PRODUCE ADEQUATE SETTLEMENT AND A NATIONAL STRIKE BEGAN AT 7 AM WASHINGTON TIME TODAY THE STRIKE WILL AFFECT GRAIN MOVEMENT NOT ONLY IN THE UNITED STATES BUT ALSO EXPORT MOVEMENT. EXPORT TONNAGE ALREADY RUNNING WELL BEHIND A YEAR AGO.
