WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW; APRIL 11-17, 1991. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00-2.50 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE VERY UNEVEN, \$3.50 HIGHER TO \$8.00 LOWER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$1.50 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE 50 CENT LOWER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00-5.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 6% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 4% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 23 POUND3 HAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$5.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$3.50 HIGHER. LAMB PRODUCTION

WAS 4% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 8% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.
