MARKETS IN REVIEW; APRIL 18-24, 1991. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.75-2.50 LOWER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE 50 CENT TO \$2.25 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO 75 CENT LOWER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$3.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 5% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 5% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 22 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

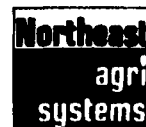
