

Barley Reports On Survey

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — In a recent public opinion survey conducted by Rep. John E. Barley, 65.7 percent of the respondents favored the privatization of the state's liquor sales, while 34.3 percent opposed the idea.

"With the state facing a growing budget deficit, we must look for ways to help cut spending," Barley said. "I have advocated allowing the private sector to take over certain state government operations such as licensing vehicles, prisons and medical assistance.

"By selling the state liquor stores, Pennsylvania will collect

between \$400 and \$650 million," Barley said. "However, the state will maintain strict licensing procedures and enforcement of present laws relating to alcohol sales and distribution."

In regard to the debate on establishing nutrient management regulations for landowners and farmers, nearly 72 percent agreed that the Commonwealth should grant administration of such a program to the Agriculture Department rather than the Department of Environmental Resources (DER).

Barley sponsored House Bill 448, which would give the Agri-

culture Department oversight of nutrient management programs. The bill has met opposition from House Democrats who are pushing to have the program become part of the DER.

"My concern is that DER is already overloaded in their responsibilities. Additionally, I believe that the Agriculture Department will be more understanding of the problems farmers and landowners face in developing nutrient management plans," Barley said.

A related question showed that 64.2 percent supported the division of DER into separate

agencies.

"Many people believe DER has grown beyond control. Presently, DER is responsible for such programs as maintaining the 114 state parks, permitting of storage tanks, and inspecting mining operations," Barley said.

"Some favor dividing the agency into two or more separate agencies, such as the Department of Parks and Recreation and the Department of Environmental Resources."

Additionally, only 46.7 percent believe the state is adequately addressing environmental issues.

Other responses included:
 — Do you support the concept of limiting who can be held legally liable for defective products?
 Yes - 68.7; No - 31.3.
 — Do you believe the state is

doing enough to assist in locating convenient and affordable day care?

Yes - 62.0; No - 38.0.
 — Should the state's law regarding the use of radar as a method of speed control be expanded to permit local police departments access to such devices?

Yes - 44.2; No - 55.8.
 — Are you satisfied with the state's auto insurance reform law that went into effect on July 1, 1990?

Yes - 55.7; No - 44.3.
 — Have you received a reduction in your yearly premium (auto insurance)?
 Yes - 65.9; No - 34.1.
 Barley said that a total of 2,375 people in the 100th District responded to his survey.

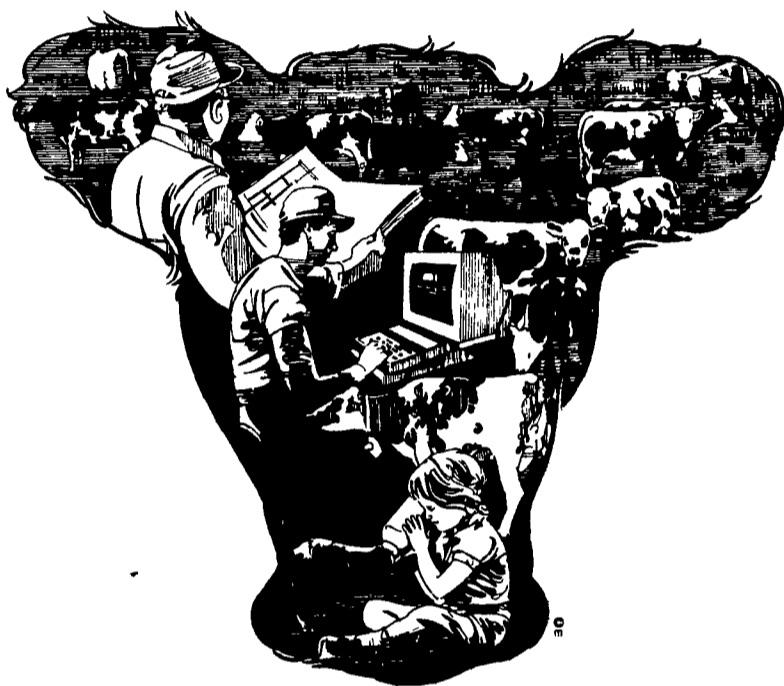
