May 9, 1991 MARKETS IN REVIEW; MAY 2-8. 1991. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$4.00 LOWER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$2.00-3.50 HIGHER. BEEF PRO-DUCTION WAS 5% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT WAS 3% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVEAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 12 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE 50-75 CENT LOWER. LAMB PRODUC-TION WAS 5% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 3% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 3 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A

YEAR AGO. SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIR-GINIA WERE STEADY. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE 50 CENT TO \$2.00 LOWER EXCEPT LOINS WHICH WERE \$5.00-8.50 HIGHER. HOG PRO-DUCTION WAS 1% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 4% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE THE SAME AS LAST YEAR.

THE VIRGINIA DIRECT HOG MARKET MAY 2-8, 1991. RECEIPTS FOR THE DIRECT HOG MARKET IN VIRGINIA FOR THE PERIOD TOT-ALED 3,864 HEAD COMPARED TO LAST WEEK 2,610 HEAD. 
