Gleaning For The Poor And Hungry Begins

retreats for young people to learn about hunger and to actually glean. The other is the "Potato Project," said Colyott.

"During the first three years of the Potato Project, over 30 million pounds of nutritious but unmarketable potatoes were distributed to the hungry in the United States," she said.

During 1990, more than 810,000 pounds of produce were gleaned and salvaged through Harvest of Hope's gleaning network, About 3,000 gleaners participated in 134 gleaning events in Maryland, Virginia, and North Carolina. Seventy-six agencies and food banks, plus three housing projects in inner-city Washington, D.C. received produce from these gleanings.

According to Colyott, this year's goal is 850,000 pounds of produce.

"Each year, about 60 million tons of grain, fruit and vegetables are wasted — enough food to feed

49 million people a day," said Colyott. "Between 13 and 18 million people die each year from the effects of hunger. Evern here in the United States, people go hungry every day. Tragically, children suffer the most."


