SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$1.75 HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE VERY UNEVEN, COWS WERE 50 CENT TO \$1.00 LOWER WHILE BULLS WERE \$1.00-1.50 HIGHER. PRODUCTION WAS 2% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT WAS 4% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 10 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$1.50 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 5% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 6% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE THE SAME AS LAST YEAR.
