WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW; MAY 23-29, 1991. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$3.00 LOWER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE VERY SCARCE WITH A FEW SELLING MOSTLY STEADY.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00-5.00 HIGHER. PRODUCTION WAS 1% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT WAS 1% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 11 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$3.00-5.00 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 2% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 1% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE 50 CENT HIGHER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE MOSTLY \$4.00 HIGHER WITH LOIN PRICES NOT ESTABLISHED TOWARD THE END OF THE WEEK. HOG PRODUCTION WAS 5% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 2% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

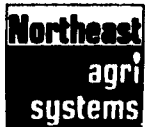
