- Oversee that retrofit programs are initiated to update older equipment with new shielding and decals.

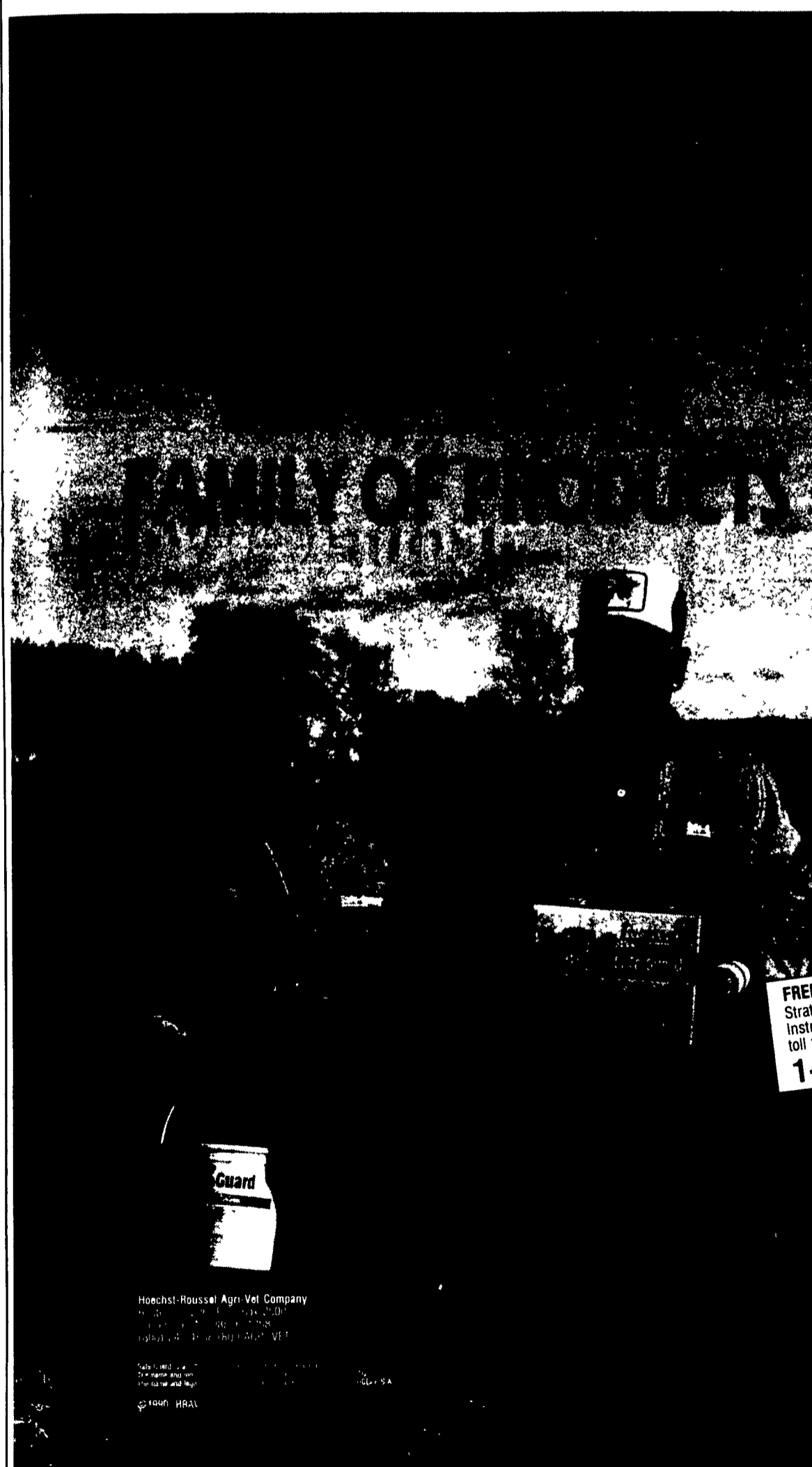
- Review products using a hazard analysis system.
