WHEAT PRICES MIXED CORN AND BEAN PRICES HIGHER WEDNESDAY. WHEAT MIXED, STEADY TO 1 CENT HIGHER IN KANSAS CITY AND PORTLAND BUT ST. LOUIS 5 TO 6 CENTS LOWER; CORN 3 TO 4 CENTS HIGHER; SORGHUM 5 TO 8 CENTS HIGHER; SOYBEANS 3 TO 6 CENTS HIGHER. HARD WHEAT PRICES CON-TINUED HIGHER, SUPPORTED BY NEWS OF PHILIPPINE BIDDING FOR LARGE AMOUNT OF EXPORT BONUS WHEAT AS WELL AS CHINA. HOT, MOSTLY DRY WEATHER ON TAP FOR MUCH OF THE CENTRAL U.S. WHEAT HARVEST PROGRESSING BUT NOT WITHOUT CONCERNS OVER YIELD QUALITY FROM DIS-EASED CROPS. SOFT RED WHEAT PRICES SUBSTANTIALLY LOWER DUE TO POOR CROP QUALITY IN CORN PLANTS, FORCING QUITE A BIT OF SOFT WHEAT INTO FEED CHANNELS. CORN AND SOYBEANS ALSO ADVANCED STRENGTHENED BY REPORTS SOVIET CREDIT ALLO-CATIONS TO BE ANNOUNCED SOON AND BUYING EXPECTED TO BEGIN IMMEDIATELY. CORN PLANTING FINISHED AND ANALYSTS BELIEVE BETWEEN 1 TO 1.5 MILLION ACRES WERE NOT PLANTED. CROP RAT-INGS DECLINED SLIGHTLY LAST WEEK BUT 78 PERCENT OF U.S. CROP IS IN GOOD TO EXCELLENT CONDITION. DRY AREAS OF THE CORNBELT ARE CONFINED MOST-LY TO ILLINOIS, IOWA AND OHIO. IOWA HAS DECLARED MORE COUN-TIES DISASTER AREAS AFTER HEAVY RAINFALL IN NORTHERN IOWA OVER THE WEEKEND. EXPORT NEWS: NONE REPORTED.


