who raises Suffolk sheep.

Grand champion winner for the day was Garth Campbell, 18, Gratz, Dauphin Co. He showed a Suffolk lamb which was purchased from Ben and Mary Bow of Annville. Campbell claimed a purse of \$150 for making the 8-hour round trip to Meyersdale.

Earning \$75 for his reserve grand champion, a Hampshire, was Josh Cowell, Waynesburg, Greene County. Cowell said his sheep was purchased from Don Witt Club Lambs, Champion.

Tegan Hayes, 14, of Somerset took the title of senior master shepherd with her Suffolk lamb, while Jarod Hoover, 13, of Rockwood was named junior master shepherd. With the other entries in this category, Hayes and Hoover had to take the multiple choice written portion, judge lambs in a pen, and do the grooming and handling. For winning, they each received a plaque and an engraved shepherd's crook.

Heidi Svonavec of Rockwood was named the county winner.


