newest way to check for nitrogen needs with a hand-held tester developed in Japan for rice production. The meter checks the corn plant leaves for chlorophyll. By reading the chlorophyll content of various leaves in the field, an evaluation can be made of nitrogen needs.

Steve Fisher, FMC representative, showed application systems on a corn planter that he developed to use as a closed system. In a system, the chemicals are never touched by the operator. FMC has pioneered the use of special couplers even on small containers of chemicals, along with special metering systems so that the applicator does not need to carry large amounts of mixed chemicals in the planter tanks. In addition, at the end of the season, extra inventory and all the empty containers are returned to FMC to eliminate the problem of

pesticide container disposal for the farmer.

Don Robinson, vo-ag instructor who chairs the annual field tour, said the event is run to give dealers some answers to many of the questions they are asked by farmers. "By bringing them here, we multiply our effectiveness in teaching," Robinson said. "We show them weeds and what is controlled and not controlled by different herbicide families. We show insect damage and the new products on the market. We also look at equipment to safely introduce the pesticides into a sprayer. With all the regulations that are coming, this will be a very vital subject."

After the tour, the group came back for a picnic in the park. Along with Fisher, Tara Luongo, Ciba-Geigy representative, sponsored the field day and picnic.
