### Lancaster 4-H Day Camp

The 4-H program serves more than 4,000 youth in Lancaster County throughout the year. The traditional program has long been recognized for its excellence with rural youth but we are equally as competent in the urban sector.

From May until August, the Lancaster County 4-H program will be providing nutrition, citizenship, and self-esteem building programs to Lancaster City youth between the ages of 8 and 12.

The programs will be built around the 4-H foods and nutrition curriculum. This curriculum emphasizes proper nutrition for youth, preparing healthy and good tasting snacks, and food handling and safety procedures.

By combining time and talents with the YWCA, Girls Club/Boys Club, Girl Scouts, City Housing Programs, and the Salvation Army, we will be able to make this program available to approximately 300 youth, which includes every elementary school in the School District of Lancaster.

As part the Lancaster 4-H citizenship and self-esteem building curriculum, there will be a day camp on Thursday, July 18, 1991 at Williamson Pavilion in Lancaster County Park from 10:30 a.m. to 12 noon. This activity is the culmination of our summer program.
