WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW: JULY 5-10, 1991. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$2 00 HIGHER BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 14% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 1% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVEAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 9 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$2 25 LOWER LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 11% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 10% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIR-GINIA WERE \$1.50 LOWER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE \$3.00 TO \$11.00 LOWER. HOG PRODUCTION WAS 21% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 2% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 3 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.




