USDA DAILY NATIONAL GRAIN MARKET SUMMARY UNSETTLED WEATHER MARKET. WHEAT PRICES VERY UNEVEN FROM AREA TO AREA RANGING FROM 7 CENTS HIGHER TO 1 CENT LOWER. CORN STEADY TO 1 CENT LOWER. SORGHUM 1 TO 3 CENTS HIGHER. SOYBEANS ON A YO-YO, SHARPLY HIGHER ONE DAY AND SHARPLY LOWER THE NEXT, DROPPED 7-11 CENTS WEDNESDAY AFTER GAINING 12-18 CENTS TUESDAY. CONTINUED EXTREMELY HIGH TEMPERATURES OVER LARGE PART OF THE CORNBELT, CATCHING MANY CORNFIELDS IN THE SILKING STAGE. LIMITED MOISTURE PAST TWO TO FOUR WEEK'S MANY PLACES AND WITH NEAR 100 DEGREE TEMPERATURES NUMEROUS AREAS UNDER STRESS. ENTRANCE OF U.S.S.R. INTO THE CORN AND SOYBEAN MEAL MARKET THIS WEEK HELPED BOOST PRICES.

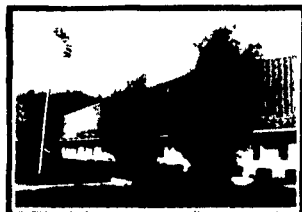
