COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$6.00 LOWER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 17% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 2% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 11 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$2.50 HIGHER. LAMB

PRODUCTION WAS 11% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 5% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$2.00 HIGHER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE \$3.00-9.00 LOWER. HOG PRODUCTION WAS 33% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 9% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

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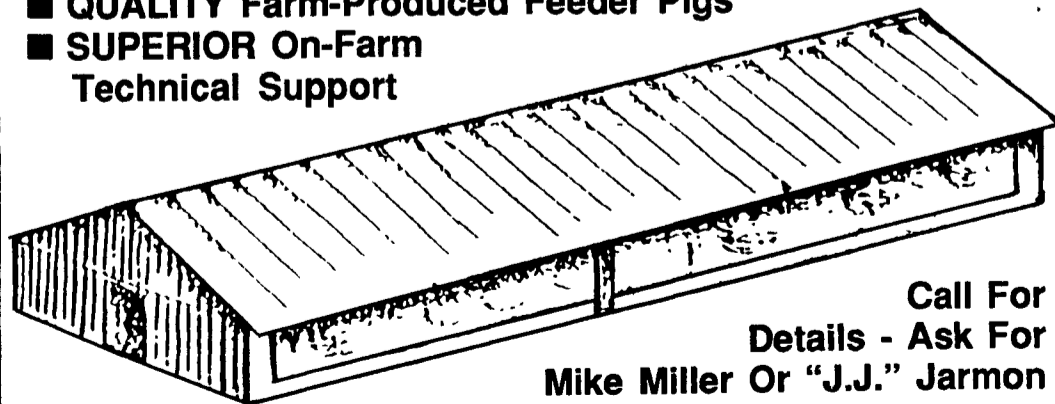


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
