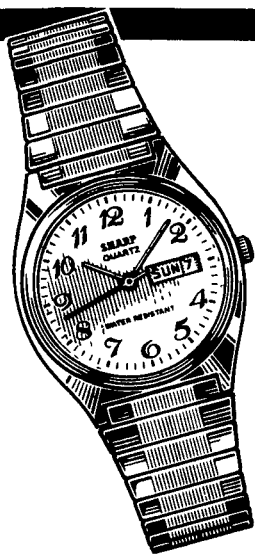

Being **SHOCK RESISTANT**, your work watch will continue to work when it is slapped by a cow's tail, a falling board, or the belt shield that your arm slams against when your wrench slips off the bolt. While your watch is scraped by branches, rubbed against walls, and knocked against machinery, the low profile, **SCRATCH RESISTANT**, glass crystal will resist the scratches and cracks that render watches unreadable. Finally, the **BATTERY POWERED QUARTZ** movement of your work watch is accurate to within 2 minutes per year, and does not need to be wound, meaning that your watch will be on time, all the time, without any effort on your part.

In order to prove that this watch will be durable we gave one to a fruit grower and had him test it for us against moisture, dust, and shock. The watch resisted the moisture surrounding spraying trees, washing fruit, making apple cider, and picking fruit in the morning while the leaves were drenched with dew. The dust from dirt roads didn't affect his watch, nor did the constant rubbing and bumping it endured while he reached in and out of trees, and while he repaired his equipment. Even the shock of walking out of a walk-in cooler into the hot summer sun didn't stop his watch. After he tested his watch we knew we could offer it as a durable and reliable work watch.

But this work watch isn't only tough, it also has some super side benefits. The **EXPANSION BAND** is very comfortable, is made of stainless steel so that it will not rust when you sweat, and can be adjusted to fit your wrist (send your wrist measurement with your order and we will size it for you). The round dial features easy to read **FULL NUMERALS**, allowing you to tell the time at a glance, as well as a calendar to help you keep track of the **DAY AND DATE**. And just in case you have need to time something, your work watch also has a second hand.

A final proof of the strength of this watch and of its suitability to your needs is the warranty. If your work watch stops running within **FIVE YEARS** of the date of purchase, the manufacturer will repair or replace your watch at no charge.
