MARKETS IN REVIEW: JULY 25-31, 1991. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE - NONE SOLD.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY \$.50 TO \$2.25 LOWER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 6% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 3% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 10 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$.75 TO \$7.50 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 10% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 2% BELOW A YEAR AGO.

AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00 LOWER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE MIXED \$5.00 HIGHER TO \$4.00 LOWER. HOG PRODUCTION WAS 3% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 7% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE THE SAME AS LAST YEAR.

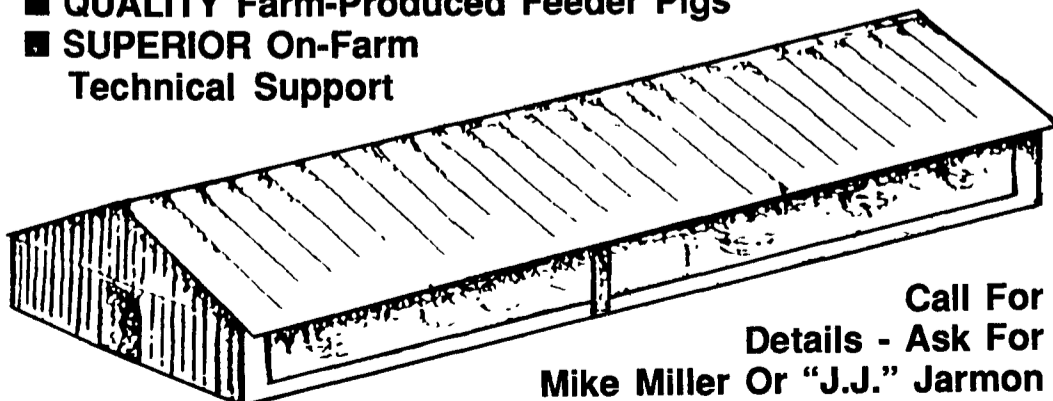


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
