offices will be combining their efforts with this, trainings will probably be held in the Titusville area.

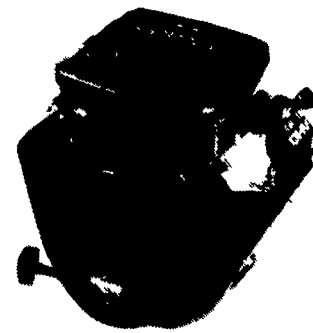

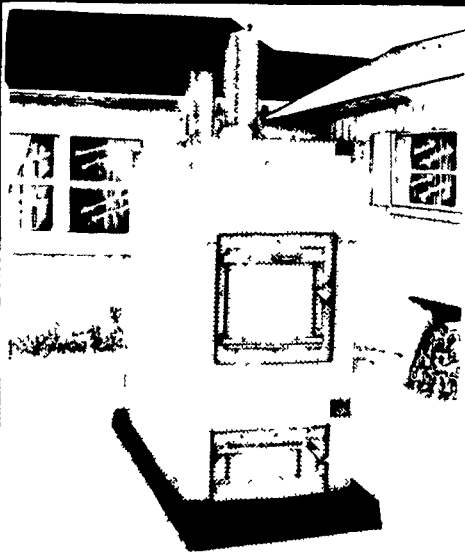
